The CPNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

CPNC BALLOT

Stakeholder who lives, works, owns property or declares a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it and who is 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Residential Renters Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Home/Condo Owners Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Retail/Service Businesses Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Community Based Organizations Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Service Organizations Representative Vote for one (1)
- Faith Based Organizations Representative Vote for one (1)
- At Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

Summary:

- The CPNC has 25 Board seats. **Twenty-one** are elected, but only **11** seats will be up for election due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The CPNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
