Let me begin by stating that I have no position on renaming as section of Hollywood as "Peru Village". My challenge is base on the democratic principles and bylaws of the Neighborhood Council system and the Central Hollywood Neighborhood Council. All five open seats of the CHNC have been filled with candidates that do not live in the boundaries of the CHNC and do not have legitimate interests in the CHNC area. All five of the elected candidates stated that they represent an organization named "Peru Village", which is not a non-profit nor community organization. Peru Village is a business development project. "Peru Village" is not an entity that can have stakeholder status in the CHNC.
