Let me begin by stating that I have no position on renaming as section of Hollywood as "Peru Village". My challenge is base on the democratic principles and bylaws of the Neighborhood Council system and the Central Hollywood Neighborhood Council. All five open seats of the CHNC have been filled with candidates that do not live in the boundaries of the CHNC and do not have legitimate interests in the CHNC area. All five of the elected candidates stated that they represent an organization named "Peru Village", which is not a non-profit nor community organization. Peru Village is a business development project. "Peru Village" is not an entity that can have stakeholder status in the CHNC. All five of the elected candidates received approximately the same number of votes. Marcy R Olachea - 206 Irma Garate - 220 Milagros F. Lizarraga - 215 Emilio Vega - 206 Juan Carlos Jimenez - Studio City 211 Examination of voter documentation will demonstrate that the number of voters declaring "Peru Village" as their stakeholder status closely matches the number of votes received by the five elected candidates. These voters are not legitimate stakeholders. Nearly half of the voters do not have legitimate stakeholder status. The election is not legitimate. Analyzing the historical voting record for the CHNC will show the 2014 election results to be anomalous and suspect. Obtaining supporting documents within the five day filling limit is not possible. Specifically; - Election records for current & previous CHNC elections will be required. - Physical addresses of the 5 elected candidates need to be verified - Current work addresses of the 5 elected candidates need to be verified -

Records concerning Peru Village pseudo-organization need to be researched. - The legitimacy of Peru Village as a stakeholder needs to be determined. The residents and true stakeholders of the Central Hollywood Neighborhood are not served by board members that do not have a legitimate claim to stakeholder status. "Peru Village" is not a non-profit or registered organization, but rather a group of activists and developers. They can advocate their position at the CHNC meetings, but they cannot be board members. Disqualify candidates that do not have a legitimate stakeholder claim. 4. Sanction the elected candidates: The newly elected candidates who have stated or demonstrated links to the pseudo-organization currently known as "Peru Village" should not be able to be advocate nor vote for any actions involving the "Peru Village" development or any associated business transactions. 6. Hold a new election.
