Rampart Village Neighborhood Council (RVNC) Ballot Voting Model

The RVNC Ballot Voting Model has three (3) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in the neighborhood and are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Resident Tenants Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Business Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Homeowner Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Based Organization Representative Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Community Interest Representative Vote for one (1)

STUDENT YOUTH BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in the neighborhood and are between the ages of 16 and 18 can vote for the following races:

- Student Representative - Vote for one (1)

AT-LARGE BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in the neighborhood or who declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder and are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- Community Interest Representative - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The RVNC has 11 Board seats. All 11 are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The RVNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
