# Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council (STNC) Ballot Voting Model

The STNC Ballot Voting Model has four (4) different ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

### 1) REGION 1 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property, or declare a stake within Region 1 and affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Region 1 Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- President Vote for one (1)
- First Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Second Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Secretary Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer Vote for one (1)
- Stakeholder Group Representatives Vote for up to eight (8)

### 2) REGION 2 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property, or declare a stake within Region 2 and affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Region 2 Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- President Vote for one (1)
- First Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Second Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Secretary Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer Vote for one (1)
- Stakeholder Group Representatives Vote for up to eight (8)

#### 3) REGION 3 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property, or declare a stake within Region 3 and affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Region 3 Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- President Vote for one (1)
- First Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Second Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Secretary Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer Vote for one (1)
- Stakeholder Group Representatives Vote for up to eight (8)

## 4) REGION 4 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property, or declare a stake within Region 4 and affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Region 4 Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- President Vote for one (1)
- First Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Second Vice-President Vote for one (1)
- Secretary Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer Vote for one (1)
