# United Neighborhoods Neighborhood Council (UNNC) Ballot Voting Model

The UNNC Ballot Voting Model has seven (7) ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and be issued one (1) ballot.

## 1) AT LARGE BALLOT

UNNC stakeholders who live, work or own real property in the neighborhood and also to those who declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the neighborhood council's boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations, and who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives - Vote for up to five (5)

# 2) AREA 1 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 1 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 1 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

#### 3) AREA 2 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 2 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 2 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

#### 4) AREA 3 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 3 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 3 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

### 5) AREA 4 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 4 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 4 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

# 6) AREA 5 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 5 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 5 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

#### 7) AREA 6 RESIDENT BALLOT

Resident stakeholders of Area 6 who are 14 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 6 Resident Representative Seat 2 Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to five (5)

Summary:
<ul> <li>The UNNC has 23 board seats. All 23 are elected, but only 11 seats will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.</li> <li>Stakeholders will use self-affirmation as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.</li> <li>Minimum stakeholder voting age is 14.</li> <li>The UNNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.</li> <li>Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.</li> </ul>
