The WANC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

WEST ADAMS STAKEHOLDER BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own a business, participate in community based organizations (CBOs), faith-based organizations or declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it within the WANC boundaries and who is at least 18 years old at the time of the election can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Representatives Vote for up to four (4)
- Business Representative Vote for one (1)
- Educational Representative Vote for one (1)
- Homeowner Representative Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The WANC has 13 board seats. All **13** are elected, but only **seven (7)** seats will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The WANC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
