REASON FOR CHALLENGE:	Concerns regarding Ballots Electioneering by candidates
Please state the facts for your challenge. (max 500 words)	I have 4 concerns about the elections: 1. I was on the ballot. In order to be placed on the ballot, I had to submit written proof of my stake in the community. When I arrived at the polls, I wasn't allowed a regular ballot but a provisional one because I didn't bring the written proof to the polling place. This burdensome administrative bureaucratic decision was unnecessary. 2. The poll worker gave me half-page instructions on how to submit documentation for the provisional ballot. On the page, she wrote in "April 8" (3 business days) as the due date for the written documentation. I just found out yesterday that other folks had been advised that April 6 (3 calendar days) had been the due date. This is an egregious mistake on behalf of the poll workers. 3. I witnessed several attendees turned away from the polling station. They were not offered a provisional ballot and were not given a clear explanation of why they were not allowed to vote. 4. There was illegal and immoral campaigning occurring at the actual polling place, and the pollworkers did not stop this improper action. Several Korean-speaking people were approaching voters and telling them who to vote for WHILE INSIDE THE DOORS OF THE POLLING LOCATION.
