4. **City Attorney's Office-** Neighborhood Council boards may not give a Neighborhood Purpose Grant (NPG) to a non-profit school or an LAUSD school, where a board member's child attends. The entire board is precluded from hearing the matter. It is not sufficient for the board member with the child to simply refrain from voting on the matter, the NPG will not be funded.
